The Invincible Fenians Frank and Mary Byrne were part of the Irish Land League and followers of Charles Stewart Parnell before becoming avid Fenians. They were eventually arrested and released, under suspicion of helping to plan the Phoenix Park assassinations of the British Chief Secretary for Ireland and his assistant. They fled via France and Ireland to America, dying in exile in Rhode Island, after living in New York. Frank was a member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians in Rhode Island.
